

Eligibility for D.Pharma

The minimum academic qualification for admission in D. Pharmacy is 12th or equivalent with science stream(PCM/PCB) having minimum 50% marks (45% SC/ST), and qualifying examination of Joint Entrance Examination Council, Uttar Pradesh (JEECUP) later participating in counselling to select the approved college of your choice further verifying the certificates and other required documents as prescribed by the examining body i.e. Board of Technical Education Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow during counseling or admission process.
